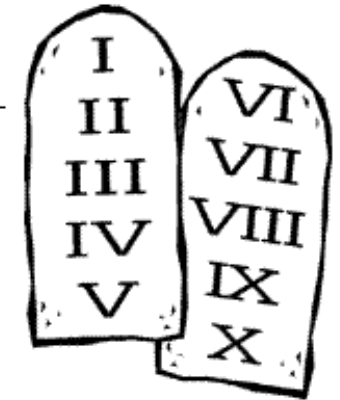

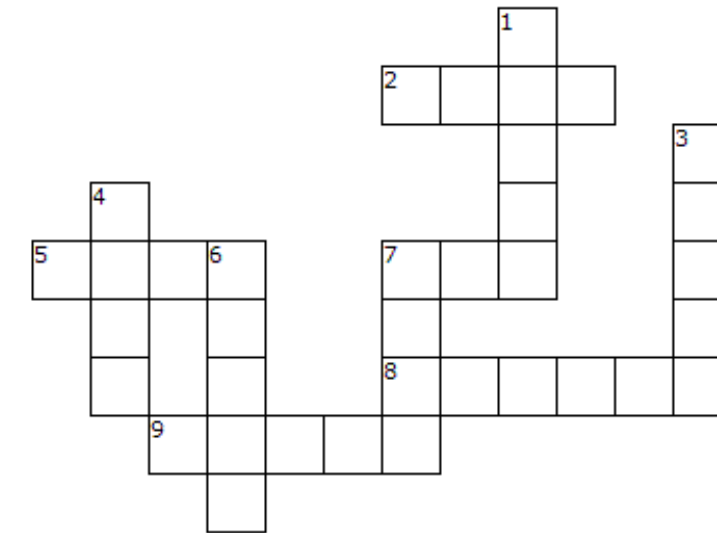
We received notice from 1st United Bank that Hope's second PPP Loan from February of 2021 in the amount of \$10,044 has been forgiven!
