pared to die for one another' "

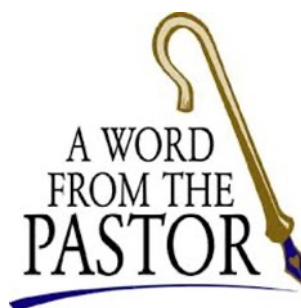

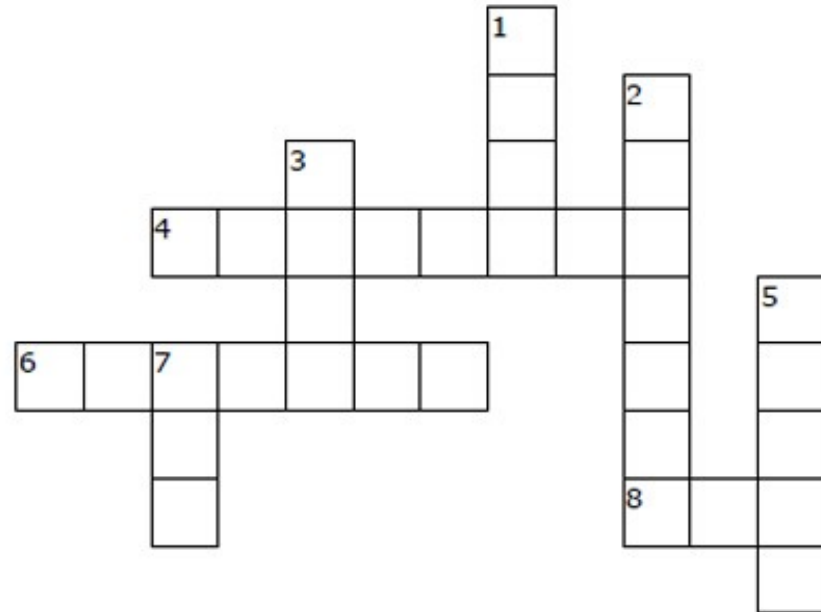
